Abstract

Instruction on Submitting Papers Accepted for Oral Presentation. This document provides information and instructions on preparing your manuscript. The page sample manuscript is presented as for your reference. Abstract length should not exceed 150 words.

Introduction

Please proceed to upload your final paper via the conference website located at <http://conference.inria.fr/waves05/>. Your final paper can be submitted using the Login ID and Password you have received when you submitted your abstract previously.

All manuscripts must be received by the due date (February 28, 2005). The Proceedings will be given at the meeting. Manuscript due dates must be strictly observed; late manuscripts run the risk of not being published. If you have a problem meeting the manuscript due date, please contact houssem.haddar@inria.fr. Refer to your Paper Number.

Methods

Please prepare your manuscript on Letter (American) size paper format (8.5in by 11in or 216mm by 279mm), using the English language. Please follow the instructions for submitting the paper listed below. The length of your paper must be between **two (2) and three (3) Letter pages** for contributed papers and **four (4) and six (6) Letter pages** for invited papers, including figures, tables, references, acknowledgements and appendices. Information must not appear outside the margins.

Please save your manuscript as a **pdf document or as a PostScript file** formatted to the following margin settings: Top & Bottom 2.0 cm (0.79 inch); Left & Right 1.5 cm (0.59 inch); Column Width 8.5 cm (3.35 inches); Between Columns 1.0 cm (0.39 inch).

AUTHORS SHOULD VIEW THE FILES to be sure that the conversion went well. Please refer to the attached templates in sample manuscript to determine the layout of your pages. The number of pages and the validity of the PDF files will be checked in real time as soon as

the document will be transmitted to the Web server. The **maximum size of the PDF or PostScript file should not exceed 15 MBytes**.

Do not include any page numbers as these will be inserted by the Editor. In addition, **the manuscript should not include headers and footers**.

Paper title and authors

The title of your paper and the author(s) name should be included in the space shown on the attached sample (title frame). Center the title. The title should be typed in ALL CAPS, Bold, Times New Roman, 11 Point. The Author(s) Names and Affiliation should be centered under the title and consist of first and middle initial and last name. The names should be Times New Roman 11 point boldface, upper and lower case letters. The name of presenting author should be underlined. The affiliation should be typed as plain text 11 point Times New Roman, and should consist only of the following as applicable: Department or Division Name, Company or Institution Name, Town, Country. Professional titles, street address, and zip codes should not be included. The e-mail address of the corresponding author should be indicated after the affiliation and should be typed as plain text 11 point Times New Roman.

Main body of the text

All text should be typed Times New Roman 11 point using single line spacing, full justification with paragraphs indented three (3), character spaces (or .25 inch), headings: bold, left hand margin, on a separate line. Sub-headings: italic, left hand margin on a separate line. Leave a blank line between headings and sub-headings and the preceding text. Footnotes must be avoided.

Illustrations and References

All images must be embedded in the document. Figures and tables should be prepared in monochrome. All lettering should be large enough to remain after inclusion of the figure in the text.

References should be numbered consecutively throughout the paper and be listed at the end of the paper with the main heading "References". When referring to them in the text, type the corresponding number in square brackets [1]. In listing the references, use the following style for each kind of publications as illustrated below.

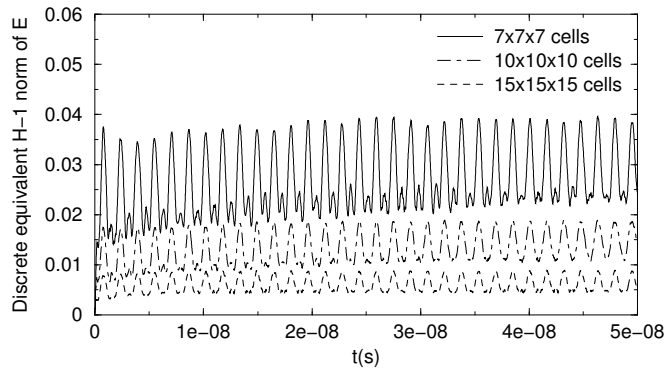


Figure 1: Whatever curves
